

Locker Agreement and Policies

Book lockers are owned and maintained by the SHHS Parent/Teacher/Student Association (PTSA). The locker program is solely a PTSA project. The use of a locker is optional. However, the fees required to operate the program are not.

Students choosing to use a book locker must enter into an agreement to accept the following terms, conditions, and policies.

LOCKER USE TERMS AND POLICIES:

- Students who elected to utilize the Locker Program must pay the current locker fee. Locker fees are non-refundable.
- Neither Sunny Hills High School nor the Parent Teacher Student Association are responsible for property loss or damage occurring from locker use. This includes damage to school and/or personal to property due to vandalism or weather.
- Students are financially responsible for stolen or damaged textbooks while using a locker.
- Students must obtain their own heavy-duty combination lock.
- Students should not leave textbooks or personal belongings in their locker overnight, for long periods of time, or during rainy weather.
- Students are advised that corridor roofs leak, during rainy weather, and water may leak into lockers. Students are responsible for damaged text books and personal items resulting from leakage.
- Students must report vandalism or theft by filling out a report in room 6.
- School administrators and security may check lockers at any time and have the authority to open lockers whenever they feel it's necessary.
- One student per locker. Sharing lockers is not permitted.

Locker fees are a necessity. Without the fee the PTSA cannot repair broken lockers, replace old lockers, or perform general maintenance such as cleaning. Other duties associated with the Locker Program are performed by volunteers.
